Worship leaders worked on the theme of Noah's Ark, supporting Mrs Swan and her team from St Hilda's Church. Mrs Swan and Reverend Anne were most impressed by the worship leaders and they would like them to help with the next Messy Church in School.





Lady Milena Grenfell-Baines visited school, telling Year 6 her inspiring story of coming to the United Kingdom as a child refugee in 1939. Lady Milena travelled on the Kindertransport organised by Sir Nicholas Winton, bringing 669 children from Prague to safety. The majority of the children were Jewish, escaping persecution by the Nazis. The children were intrigued to hear the details of Lady Milena's story, including how the older children had to look after the younger children on their long journey.






