Lady Milena Grenfell-Baines visited Year 6 this week.

Lady Milena came to this country as a child refugee in 1939, travelling with other children on Kindertransport trains from Prague. The trains were organised by Nicholas Winton, enabling more than 600 mostly Jewish children to escape from the threat of the Nazis just before the start of the Second World War.

Lady Milena praised the children's interest in her story and their questions about her experiences.

Behaviour and Emotional Health – Understanding behaviour, supporting emotional wellbeing, and helping children build resilience.

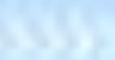
